Changes in morals and traditions, mixed cultures and migrations, globalization and the speed of global communications are causing profound changes in the couple and the family on five continents. Practitioners of psychotherapy today are often confronted with these mutations and the resulting crises. How do we think about them? How can we approach so many new and necessary questions?
